Dorothy Cox-Scruton Bursary Application Process and Criteria

This bursary commemorates the first Royal Academy of Dance member in Canada, Mrs. Dorothy Cox-Scruton who spent much of her career pursuing ways for students to advance their passion for dance without having to travel abroad. In keeping with the spirit of her vision, RAD Canada has created the Dorothy Cox-Scruton Bursary to assist Certificate in Ballet Teaching Studies (CBTS) students pursue their dance teaching career aspirations while staying in Canada.

Award Amount: \$1,500

Eligibility:

- enrolled on the CBTS program;
- a Canadian citizen or resident of Canada

Application Process will entail submitting a minimum 5 minute to a maximum 7 minute video (MOV format) which:

- First, answers the following questions, which highlight reasons why, as a candidate, you deserve the bursary (be sure to express with clarity your educational and training goals):
 - 1) What led you to dance?
 - 2) Why would you like to teach dance?
 - 3) What has been your most exciting moment on the CBTS program thus far?
 - 4) Who has been your most inspirational teacher and why?
 - 5) Why did you join the CBTS program?
- Second, summarizes your non-dance, arts related interests and activities. For example, a list of charitable activities and/or community involvement supporting theatre, music, art, poetry, public speaking, etc
- Finally, shows a demonstration of you teaching

Assessment Criteria:

- ✓ Communication skills
- ✓ Overall Presentation
- ✓ Passion for dance and dance teaching
- ✓ Charitable activities
- ✓ Personal interests and goals outside of the dance community
- ✓ Characteristics that would make a good dance teacher

Deadline for applications: Friday, May 22, 2020

Decision Date: October 2020
